

## Program Objectives:

- To improve the capacity of the Provincial Hospital to provide comprehensive care (CC) for people living with HIV/AIDS
- To set up a network of comprehensive care facilities to work with Rift Valley Provincial General Hospital (RVPGH) for treatment and referrals
- To provide anti-retroviral therapy (ART) and other services for PLWHAs in Nakuru District.

## Program Overview:

- Selection of Nakuru District
  - High prevalence in district (11.8%)
  - Population 1.2 million
  - Availability of elements of HIV/AIDS comprehensive care, including VCT, STI OI management, TB, PMTCT, RH, and home-based care
- Program Sites: Provide opportunity to introduce various aspects of comprehensive care at various levels of health care services, thereby offering multiple entry points for CC services within the same catchment areas linked through referral network.
  - **Rift Valley Provincial General Hospital** serving southern Rift Valley and Nakuru, fourth largest urban area in the country. CCC has VCT, PMTCT, ART initiation and monitoring, OI management, TB clinic, STI clinic, nutrition counseling, youth VCT and center, home-based care and referral programs. USAID and FHI have also constructed and equipped a regional blood transfusion center in Nakuru.
